# 1 Design Options

This section describes the general settings that are used for all pages. All these settings will help to create the framework of the design and will be the starting point for future elements design. You have to view these settings as a base for your design.

# 1.1 Global Variables

We apply a common set of options as core customization to ensure uniform integration of all our products and extensions.

Settings	<ul> <li>theme-setting-globalwidth (default: 1280px) Max width for user pages</li> <li>theme-setting-globalradius Global border radius for buttons and cards</li> </ul>
Colours - Main	<ul> <li>theme-colour-primary Primary colour (used on buttons and links)</li> <li>theme-colour-primary-over Colour over the primary colour. If theme-colour-primary is the background then this is the foreground</li> <li>theme-colour-secondary Secondary colour (used on buttons and links)</li> <li>theme-colour-secondary-over Colour over the secondary colour. If theme-colour-secondary is the background then this is the foreground</li> </ul>
Colours - Body	<ul> <li>theme-colour-body-primary The main background for the user pages</li> <li>theme-colour-body-secondary The secondary background is used to emphasize some sections over the main sections</li> <li>theme-colour-body-tertiary Tertiary background colour. If it's set the same colour for theme-colour- body-primary and theme-colour-body-secondary then use a different light colour to have some contrast on the page (ex: utfp rearrange question)</li> </ul>
Colours - Texts	<ul> <li>theme-colour-text-primary The primary text colour used as body text colour</li> <li>theme-colour-text-secondary The secondary text colour used as headline text colour</li> <li>theme-colour-text-meta The meta text colour used for the metadata row (on cards, headers)</li> </ul>
Colours - States	<ul> <li>theme-colour-success theme-colour-success-over theme-colour-success-light Used to provide visual feedback for the successful states (done, correct, completed, agree, passed, checked)</li> <li>theme-colour-alert theme-colour-alert theme-colour-alert-over theme-colour-alert-light</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Used to provide visual feedback for the alert states (error, failed, wrong, destructible action)</li> <li>theme-colour-pending theme-colour-pending-over theme-colour-pending-light Used to provide visual feedback for the pending states (pending, in progress, waiting, running)</li> <li>theme-colour-neutral theme-colour-neutral theme-colour-neutral states (not started, ended, not processed, other)</li> <li>theme-colour-info theme-colour-info-over theme-colour-info-light Used for information (notification, )</li> <li>theme-colour-disabled theme-colour-disabled-light Used for disabled-over theme-colour-disabled content</li> </ul>
Fonts	<ul> <li>theme-font-family-primary The primary font family used for the body texts</li> <li>theme-font-family-secondary The secondary font family used for headlines (page titles)</li> </ul>
Borders	<ul> <li>theme-border-primary Main border used for cards and sections</li> <li>theme-border-secondary</li> </ul>
Shadows	<ul> <li>theme-shadow-primary Shadow used for cards</li> <li>theme-shadow-secondary Shadow used for sections in a page</li> </ul>
Table	<ul> <li>theme-table-header-body</li> <li>theme-table-header-text</li> <li>theme-table-row-primary-body</li> <li>theme-table-row-primary-text</li> <li>theme-table-row-secondary-body</li> <li>theme-table-row-secondary-text</li> <li>theme-table-row-hover-body</li> <li>theme-table-row-hover-text</li> <li>theme-table-row-active-body</li> <li>theme-table-row-active-text</li> </ul>

### 1.2 Logo

The logo can be displayed only on the top-left side of the header. For complex logos, must be provided two variants: one for large screens and another for tiny screens, in order to have a responsive view of the logo (smartphone view).





# 1.3 Font Family

The global font family can be changed as needed. This can be either an external web font (ex: google fonts) or a licensed font.

For the licensed font the client must provide the web font files.

- .eot (optional)
- woff (optional)
- woff2 (mandatory)

\*If it's not requested a custom font, our standard font (Roboto) is used.
